

WHERE TO STAY IN Banks Peninsula

Annandale Coastal Farm Experience and Luxury Villa Collection.

Play lord of the manor at this historic homestead an hour from Christchurch. Tucked into Banks Peninsula's rugged hills with views over Pigeon Bay and out to the Pacific Ocean, for more than 100 years this beautiful home has delivered restrained elegance to its owners. This is what manager Lyndsay would like you to feel you are during your stay on this 1,600 hectare working farm. The Lodge offers five separate accommodation options - an historic homestead, a stylish seaside retreat, a characterful shepherd's cottage, converted stables and a secluded beach house. Each assures guests of total



seclusion from the outside world, with the option of a sociable table d'hôte dinner at the end of the day.

But there's no need to get your hands dirty at this particular farm. Leave the sheep and cattle to Andrew and Naomi while you explore Annandale's 10km of coastline; or tag along with them

to watch the dogs at work, or the shearing gang in the shed (some of that wool made the rugs you've been walking on). Or you could just go play,

messing around in boats in Pigeon Bay's turquoise waters, or riding a mountain bike on the farm. That won't reveal all the other accommodation options, though: Seascape is an ultra-modern retreat accessible only by helicopter or 4WD, so remote in its private cove, with the sea right outside, that you could watch rare Hector's dolphins while surrounded by luxury. How about taking a bunch of friends to the architectural marvel that is Scrubby Bay, in a similarly private setting, and doing your own thing? Or settle into the cute little Shepherd's Cottage on its hilltop? Wherever you lay your head, you're assured that not only is your every need met, but pretty much all your desires, too. annandale.com
